## Topics of note from the Parish meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup> July 2019

A business packed meeting saw Hylary Kingham accept the Vice Chairman role and councillors discuss a number of issues including finance, policies, proposed and recent works affecting the village.

The council has reassurances from the contractors of the recent **fibre optic cabling** that remedial work will be undertaken this summer to improve installations in a number of locations throughout the village.

The **vehicle activated speed sign** working group reported on proposals and investigations so far, however councillors are still seeking volunteers within the village to support this project. If you would like to be involved, do contact the clerk.

The **telephone kiosk** on Tibberton Lane has been used for some interesting displays recently including a study on hedgehogs. Councillors are seeking ideas from groups in the village for other uses for this unique location, do contact the clerk with your ideas.



In the unlikely event of a disaster in the village the Parish Council is duty bound to be ready to provide support and guidance. The council is working to update the **Emergency Plan** for the village.

The county crossing Wysis Way footpath passes through the parish along with many other footpaths. Council were advised Gloucestershire CC is digitally mapping all footpaths in the county to be finalised by 2026.

(*Google: GCC PROW for more information.*) A '**Parish footpath walk**' is therefore being planned by councillors on a date to be agreed later this year. Volunteers will be sought to walk the footpaths of Tibberton and confirm the online mapping of footpaths across the parish.
