Topics of note from the Parish meeting on the 11th November 2019

Do we want more housing, better footways, or an eco-friendly project in Tibberton or just change nothing? What do we want?

The council is looking for parishioners to join a working party to start work from January 2020 and produce a plan for 2022. **Tibberton Neighbourhood Development Plan (TNDP)** is an opportunity for the Parish to “shape the community” for the future to 2042. If you would like to contribute or get involved, do contact the clerk.

Meanwhile the council continues work on the **Emergency Plan** for the village and introducing a **Vehicle Activated Speed (VAS) sign**.

The council would like to introduce a ‘**pedestrian safety barrier**’ on the footpath from the school to Tibberton Lane, by the telephone box. Planning issues and recent applications were also discussed.

The council have received concerns about the encroachment of the hedges and trees of private properties narrowing the village roads and footways. The potential for dangerous incidents and damage to road verges is a cause for concern to everyone. **The Parish Council asks all landowners through the village to ensure hedges and trees are properly maintained and do not encroach onto our village roads and footways.**

The Parish Council are pleased to provide donations on request of £250 each towards the upkeep of the Tibberton Churchyard and the Newent Dial-a-Ride service.

District Councillors reported on the proposed new £22m Hospital to be built in Cinderford and available to residents of Tibberton. Also the County Council transport planning for a possible transport hub at Highnam.
