Topics of note from the Parish meeting on the 13th January 2020

The Parish Council asks all landowners throughout the village ensure **hedges and trees that encroach onto our village roads and footways are properly maintained**. The potential for dangerous incidents and damage to road verges is a cause for concern to everyone.

Councillors and the public also raised concerns about the risks and dangers posed by **large tractor and trailers and their inconsiderate use** of the village lanes including reported near "misses". Advice to be taken from Police and letters to be sent to farmers/contractors expressing the council's concern.

The Parish Council are pleased to provide a £250 donation towards the Taynton and Tibberton Village Hall kitchen development.

Meanwhile the council continues work on the **Emergency Plan** for the village and introducing a **Vehicle Activated Speed (VAS) sign**.

Issues from recent and past planning applications were discussed including the retrospective application for a recycling site at Bovone Farm. The decision is currently with the County Council and the Parish Council has published their comments however given the level of interest the meeting was adjourned for a public discussion on this topic.

Work starts soon on devising a **Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP)** for our village, an opportunity for residents to shape our community for the future. What do we want Tibberton to look like in 2040. If you would like to contribute or be consulted, do contact the Clerk.

The County Councillor reported on the County budget for Children's, Schools and Adult services and also the £150 million road resurfacing plan.
