

Tibberton Parish Council

At the September Tibberton Parish Council meeting Councillors considered the adoption of **community land next to the telephone box** with the purpose of landscaping the area, erecting a noticeboard and maintaining the area as a community facility at the centre of the village. Options being considered:

- Remove the Telephone box?
- Should there be a display cabinet or larger noticeboard?
- Should there be a covered seating area?
- Should there be a village sign?
- How big should a new noticeboard be?
- What are your ideas for this part of the village?



The Parish Councillors are keen to hear villagers' views directly or respond on NextDoor on what could be a more attractive centre point for the village.

The **Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS)** awaits Gloucestershire County Council (GCC) to install posts for the VAS at four sites along the village roads. Road safety problems for vehicles and pedestrians created by overgrown hedges encroaching onto the lanes of Tibberton remain a concern. The Council appeals to property owners for action on the removal of roadside hedge foliage.

Polluting smoke and fumes from garden bonfires have caused a number of complaints by villagers and the Council ask perpetrators to consider the impact on neighbours. It is an offence to cause a nuisance from "smoke, fumes or gases prejudicial to health". Councillors advise in the first instance, if bothered by smoke, "approach your neighbour and explain the problem".
